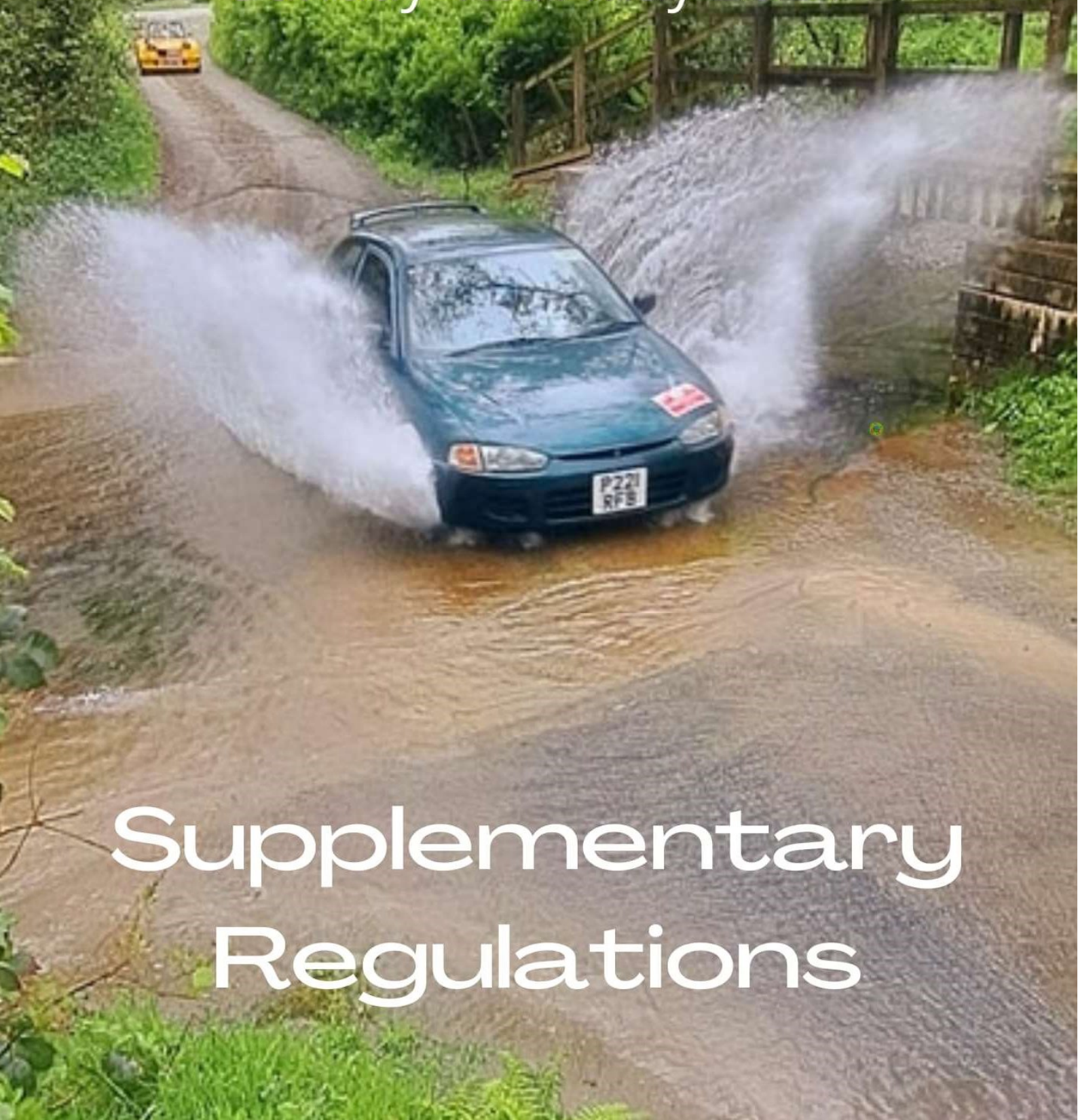




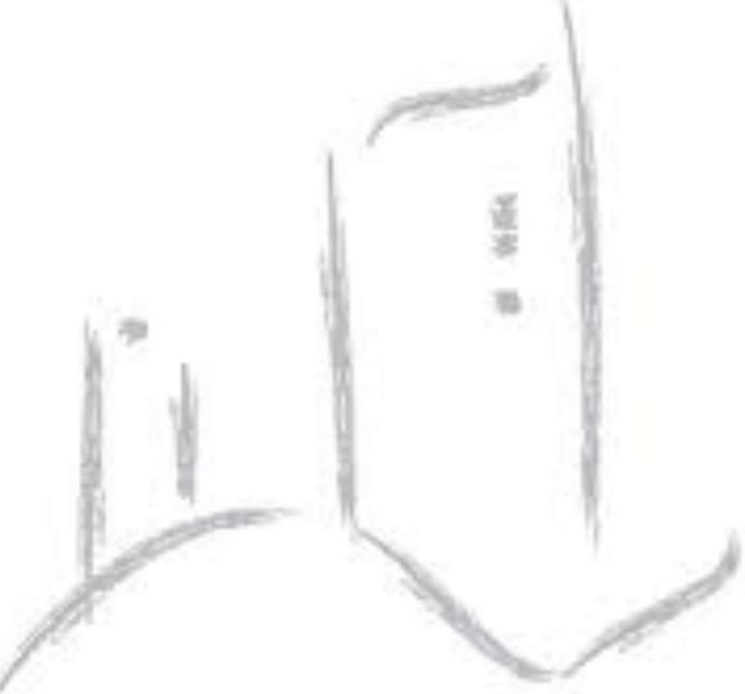

The Tour is open to all and planned to be a fun family day out.

The event is not timed and will provide a relaxed tour along classic roads and amid beautiful scenery. Both classic and modern cars are welcome.

Once again, the Tour will start in Llanwrtyd Wells but this year finish at The Castle Hotel, Llandovery.

**Supplementary Regulations**  
**Organisation**

1. Epynt Motor Club Ltd. will organise the Cambrian Mountains Tour on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2024.
2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK, these Regulations and any other written instructions given by the organisers.

**Authorisation**

3. The Motorsport UK permit number for the event is 134835.

**Eligibility**

4. The event is open to members of the organising club, members of the HRCR and members of WAMC affiliated clubs. Members of the public, who are not members of a motor club, are also invited to participate.
5. Entrants are welcome to join Epynt Motor Club if not already a member. Please complete the online [Membership Form](#).
6. Drivers must hold a valid driving licence. A specific competition licence is not required.
7. All cars must be in road-worthy condition, must hold a V5C Registration Document, be taxed and insured for use on the public highway and carry a valid MOT certificate, if applicable.

**Entries**

8. Entries are open from the publication of these regulations and will close on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2024.
9. The entry fee is £75 per car, which includes the Driver and Co-driver. Additional adult passengers will be charged at £20, with additional child passengers up to the age of 16 at a reduced entry fee of £10 each. Children under five years of age are free of charge.
10. The entry fee includes a map book and tour plate, coffee and cake at the start, and a two-course Sunday roast carvery at the finish.
11. All entries must be made using the [Online entry form](#) and must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.
12. The maximum number of cars will be 75 with a minimum of 30. Should the minimum number of cars not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and will return any received entries in full.
13. Entry payment is preferred by direct payment to our bank account using telephone or internet banking. Please make the payment to:

14. Cheques will also be accepted. Please make cheques payable to Epynt Motor Club Ltd and write the driver's name on the back.
15. Entries will be acknowledged and accepted by email.
16. Final instructions, including an entry list, will be available to download from [www.epyntmc.co.uk](http://www.epyntmc.co.uk).
17. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving their reasons.
18. Cancelled entries must be made as soon as possible to the Entries Secretary. Entry fees will be refunded up to the closing date without penalty, although entrants wishing to cancel after this date will be refunded less a £10 administration fee.
19. If the maximum number of entries is received, reserve entries will be held in abeyance and will be notified as soon as possible if an entry becomes available. If an entry does not become available, a full refund will be given.
20. Entrants under 18 years of age will be permitted. Where the Parent is not present there must be a Guardian who must produce a written and signed authorisation from the Parent/Guardian to act as their representative.

## Route

21. The event will start at the Bromsgrove Hall, Dolecoed Road, Llanwrtyd Wells, Powys, LD5 4RA.
22. There will be a mid-morning break at Hafod Arms Hotel, Devils Bridge,
23. There will be a lunch time comfort break at Bont Rally Stage, Pontrhydfendigaid, where refreshments will be available to purchase.
24. The event will finish at The Castle Hotel, Llandovery where a two course Sunday roast will be provided.
25. The route will be covered on OS maps 135,146,147 and 160
26. The route will total approximately 130 miles.
27. Entrants are to be advised that the whilst most of the route uses roads that allow two-way traffic some roads are single carriageway, care and courtesy should be taken with regards to other road users.
28. The route will be given in an easy to follow map book of printed Ordnance Survey maps, which will be issued at signing on. Extra information will be added to the maps to help navigation and arrows will also be placed on difficult junctions.
29. There will not be any tulip diagrams, so a trip meter is not needed.
30. There will be a number of strategically placed controls located along the route, where entrants will be required to obtain a marshal's signature, answer a clue or write down a code. There will be a small prize for the finisher with the most visited controls and correct answers!
31. There will be no timing element, but entrants may be requested to wait at manned controls to allow the event to maintain reasonable gaps between cars.

37. Entrants will be issued with a map book, tour plate and route check cards upon successful completion of documentation.

38. The tour plate must be affixed to the car in a forward-facing position, cable ties will be provided.
