2022 Autotest Championship Rules

The 2022 Autotest Championship rounds are:

February 13th - Royal Welsh Agricultural Showground, Builth Wells

April 24th - Crychan Forest, Tirabad

June 12th - New Radnor TBC

August 14th - Graig Goch Farm, Newbridge-on-Wye

October 9th - Esgair Dafydd Forest, Llanwrtyd Wells

December 11th - Royal Welsh Agricultural Showground, Builth Wells

All autotests will start at 10.30am.

Signing On will start from 9:30am

The entry fee for each autotest is £25.

There are five classes: Front Wheel Drive, Rear Wheel Drive, Standard Production, Novice and Ladies

Rules

1. All competitors must be fully paid up members of Epynt Motor Club Ltd. Every competitor must show his/her current Club Card at the start of an Autotest. Any competitor who cannot show his/her Club Card at the start of an event will have to reapply for membership. After proof of membership is found, £5.00 will be refunded to the competitor.
2. All competitors must hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman or higher grade competition licence. A Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition Licence is free of charge and can be applied for online at www.motorsportuk.org or at signing on for each autotest.
3. A competitor must be at least 16 years of age to compete.
4. Parents or guardians of drivers under 18 years of age are required to sign on at the start an Autotest to enable their child to compete.
5. A competitor under 18 years of age may only compete in the Standard class.
6. Penalties will be as in supplementary regulations for the event.
7. A competitor entering the novice class will remain in the novice class for the year.
8. All competitors must wear a helmet and seat belt whilst competing.
9. All cars must be fitted with an effective silencer at all times.
10. All cars in the standard class must have a STANDARD engine, NO LSD or welded diffs, NO knobbly or winter tyres and NO hydraulic handbrake.
11. A competitor's best five scores will count for the championship.
12. A first in class award will be presented for each class on every round.
13. Overall championship awards will be presented at the Epynt Motor Club Annual Dinner and Awards Presentation.
14. If competitors wish to qualify for championship awards at the end of the year they must marshal on at least one rally that Epynt Motor Club will be officiating on and help at one or more club event. There are 2 classes - Expert and Novice

Rules

1. All competitors must be fully paid up members of Epynt Motor Club Ltd. Every competitor must show his/her current card at the start of a navscatter. Any competitor who cannot show his/her club card at the start of an event will have to reapply for membership. After proof of membership is found, £5.00 will be refunded to the competitor.
2. All competitors must hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman or higher grade competition licence. A Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition Licence is free of charge and can be applied for online at www.motorsportuk.org or at signing on for each navscatter.
3. Parents or guardians of drivers under 18 years of age are required to sign on at the start of a navscatter to enable their child to participate.
4. If a driver or navigator is a novice on the first round he or she will remain in the novice class for the year.
5. Only two people are allowed in competing cars.
6. Spotlights must not be fitted on competing vehicles.
7. All vehicles must be fitted with an effective silencing system.
8. A driver or navigator who organises an event will get ten points.
9. Awards will be presented on every round to the first novice crew and first expert crew.
10. A competitor may count his or her best five scores for the championship.
11. Championship awards for winning drivers and navigators will be presented at the Epynt Motor Club Annual Dinner and Awards Presentation.
12. If competitors wish to qualify for championship awards at the end of the year they must marshal on at least one rally that Epynt Motor Club will be officiating on and help at one or more club event. Specific rules for navscatter organisers

1. Organisers must allow novice crews extra plotting time.
2. Organisers may use white unsurfaced roads only if they are smooth.
3. Any unsurfaced roads used or roads not on OS maps must be shown by a detailed diagram.

4. Try to arrange a start venue with a separate room for plotting and a finish venue that can supply food.
5. Contact the Navscatter Coordinator, Brian Jones, for a list of black spots and the permit number for your event.
6. Event information must be sent to the Route Liaison Officer, Andrew Thomson (Tel. 07973 118836 or email andrewthomson485@btinternet.com), at least six weeks before your event. Including the regulations, a coloured map showing all clue locations, permit number, and organisers contact details
7. PR around the start and finish venue and any clues which are within 400 meters of any household.
8. Contact Dyfed-Powys Police with full details of your event, email Nigel Nelson nigel.nelson@dyfed-powys.pnn.police.uk.
9. If required, contact the WAMC Epynt Liaison Officer with details of your event, email Chris Phillips bronant.phillips@gmail.com.
